



Expressions of Interest for State Leads

The Australian Tiny House Association is a national association and we are seeking to fill **State Lead** roles in **Western Australia and South Australia**. All ATHA roles are voluntary and we respect people's work-life balance in fulfilling the duties of these roles.

A State Lead for ATHA is a member of the Association who takes a lead role in:

- *Supporting the drive of memberships in their state.*
- *Responding to membership enquiries in their state.*
- *Organising state level meetings for the Association with State Agencies and Local Government Associations.*
- *Sourcing and managing information relevant to Association members at a state level.*
- *Contributing to the Association's national initiatives.*

Responsibilities include:

- Provide support to promotional activities for the Association undertaken in their state.
- Supply any relevant newsworthy events from their state that can be used to promote the Tiny House Sector in Australia (for example, council decisions on legal tiny living, innovative products, events aligned with ATHA's values and purpose).
- Collaborate with other State Leads to ensure alignment of information is available for each state.
- Explore opportunities to have member events (for example, a meetup style event).
- Attend the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Association (this can be done virtually) and bi-monthly meetings (held virtually).

Applicants nominating as a State Lead must be a financial member of ATHA.

Applicants expressing their interest as a State Lead will be interviewed and where accepted they will be offered an induction and trial in the role.
